Uni ID Your ID for – basically everything





- The ID consists of 2 letters and 3 numbers: ab123
- Activation: online or at one of the IT Service Points in the University Library (UB) or the URZ
- Grants access to most digital services, such as Wi-Fi, email, public printers, LSF, and much more.
- Your Uni-ID is valid for the duration of one semester and is renewed as soon you reregister for the next semester


Wi-Fi via eduroam

Free and fast





- Free, fast Wi-Fi on campus and in the city
- Available in most university buildings and in many outdoor areas of the campus and the city
- Set up easy access with Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT) and Uni ID: https://cat.eduroam.org
- Use "education roaming" at educational and research institutes worldwide



VPN - Virtual Private NetworkSecure connection on the go





- Access the university network from home or when you're out and about, e.g., protected library resources
- Secure connection in the university network
- Especially recommended when using public Wi-Fi hotspots

- Share files and jointly edit them with teachers and fellow students by inviting them via their Uni-ID <u>uni-id@uni-</u> <u>heidelberg.de</u>
- Students receive 10GB free storage space
- Save, synchronize and share term papers, study materials and lab results
- Access via browser or Seafile Client



Instant Messenger heiCHAT Secure messaging and exchange





- Internal university instant messaging: https://heichat.uni-heidelberg.de
- Secure and data protection compliant
- Collaborate with teachers and other students through:
 - messages
 - audio and video calls
 - group chats
- Can be used with a browser or with a desktop or mobile client
